On street coach parking places can be identified by white bay markings.

- 1 NCP, Dalby Avenue, Bedminster, BS3 4HH**
 - Capacity up to 20 coaches
 - Open 24 hours
 - Up to 4 hrs £4, over 4hrs £8
 - Drivers' toilet facility

Within 5 minutes driving time of all Central Bristol pick up and set down points.
- 2 Cumberland Road, Central Bristol, BS1 6SG.**
 - Capacity up to 12 coaches.
 - Waiting limit 24 hours.
 - No return within 1 hour of departure.

Within 10 minutes driving time of all Central Bristol pick up and set down points.
- 3 Bristol City Football Club, Ashton Gate, BS3 2EJ. (A3029) Winterstoke Road.**
 - Capacity up to 30 coaches.

Contact Bristol City Football Club (telephone number 0117 963 0614) in advance to agree access arrangements, waiting restrictions and fee. Secure off street coach parking within 15 minutes driving time from City Centre.
- 4 Parry's Lane, The Downs, (B4054) off Westbury Road (A4018).**
 - Capacity up to 15 coaches.
 - No waiting limit.

Within 5 minutes driving time from Bristol Zoo Gardens, The Downs, Clifton Village and the Clifton Suspension Bridge.

Set Down and Pick Up Points - Short Stay and No Waiting

Operational 24 hours / 7 days per week unless otherwise stated. No fee unless stated. On street coach parking places can be identified by white bay markings. Pick up and set down takes place on yellow lines.

- 5 Bond Street, Broadmead, Central Bristol, BS1 3LX.**
 - Coach parking place, capacity 3 coaches.
 - Waiting limit 20 minutes.
 - No return within 1 hour of departure.

Nearby attractions: Broadmead, The Mall Bristol and Cabot Circus shopping centres.
- 6 Colston Street, Central Bristol, BS1 5AR.**
 - Coach parking place, capacity 1 coach.
 - Waiting limit 20 minutes.
 - No return within 1 hour of departure.

Nearby attractions: Colston Hall, City Centre and Christmas Steps.
- 7 Broad Quay, Central Bristol, BS1 4DA.**

Please note: Direct transfer from coach to taxi or private car is not possible at Broad Quay.

 - Coach parking place, capacity 3 coaches.
 - Waiting limit 20 minutes.
 - No return within 1 hour of departure.

Nearby attractions: The Bristol Hippodrome, City Centre, Old City, St Nicholas Market and Tourist Information.
- 8 Holland House, Redcliff Hill, BS1 6SQ.**
 - Capacity 1 coach.
 - Pick up and set down only - coaches may wait on yellow lines but only whilst passengers are boarding or alighting.

Nearby attractions: Mercure Holland House Hotel and Spa, St Mary Redcliffe Church and Ramada Bristol City Hotel.
- 9 At-Bristol, Explore Lane, Harbourside, Central, Bristol, BS1 5DB.**
 - Capacity 3 coaches.
 - Waiting limit 15 minutes.
 - No return within 45 minutes of departure.

Nearby attractions: At-Bristol, Blue Reef Aquarium with 3D IMAX cinema and Tourist Information.

- 10 King Street, Central Bristol BS1 4ED.**
 - Capacity 2 coaches.
 - Pick up and set down only - coaches may wait on yellow lines but only whilst passengers are boarding or alighting.
 - Operational 0800 – 1800 Monday to Saturday.

Nearby attractions: Bristol Old Vic Theatre, Queen Square, Old City, St Nicholas Market and Tourist Information.
- 11 Ibis Hotel, Explore Lane, Harbourside, Central Bristol BS1 5TY.**
 - Capacity 1 coach.
 - Waiting limit 10 minutes.
 - Pick up and set down only - coaches may wait on yellow lines but only whilst passengers are boarding or alighting.
- 12 Maritime Heritage Centre, Gas Ferry Road, Central, Bristol BS1 6TY.**
 - Capacity 7 off street bays.
 - Waiting limit 15 minutes.
 - Driver must stay with the vehicle at all times.

Nearby attractions: Brunel's ss Great Britain and Maritime Heritage Centre, Floating Harbour and ferry boat services.
- 13 Berkeley Place, Central Bristol BS8 1EH.**
 - Capacity 1 coach.
 - No waiting at any time.
 - Pick up and set down only - coaches may wait on yellow lines but only whilst passengers are boarding or alighting.

Nearby attractions: Bristol Museum and Art Gallery, Brandon Hill, Cabot Tower and Park Street shops.
- 14 Guthrie Road, Clifton BS8 2EZ.**
 - Capacity 6 coaches.
 - No waiting at any time.
 - Pick up and set down only - coaches may wait on yellow lines but only whilst passengers are boarding or alighting.

Nearby attractions: Bristol Zoo Gardens and The Downs.

Coach Parking in Bristol



This leaflet aims to provide coach drivers and group travel organisers with information about coach parking facilities in central Bristol.

Overleaf is a map showing the location of the main tourist attractions in central Bristol and the locations of longer stay and set down/pick up facilities. Detailed information about conditions of use of each individual coach parking facility can be found at the head of the map.

Getting to Bristol is easy

From London and the South East via the M4 exit at junction 19 and join the M32.

From the Midlands and the North via the M5 exit at junction 18 (Avonmouth) and follow the A4.

From the South West via the M5 exit at junction 18 (Avonmouth) and follow the A4.

From Wales via the M4 exit at junction 19 and join the M32.

Bristol has the largest selection of retailers in the South West and has to be the number one destination for a fantastic shopping experience. Cabot Circus is the latest edition to the shopping offer in Bristol and is located in the heart of the city, adjacent to the very well established, recently modernised Broadmead, which also features The Mall Bristol. There are almost 500 stores within Bristol city centre, featuring Harvey Nichols, House of Fraser, Marks and Spencer, Debenhams, Boots, Zara, Urban Outfitters, Hollister, Apple, Waterstone's and TK Maxx. In addition a large range of shops can be found in Park Street and Clifton village. Away from the water's edge, winding streets lead to elegant parks and squares, historic buildings such as Bristol Cathedral and other attractions including the Bristol Museum and Art Gallery.

The stunning Georgian architecture of Clifton, with the iconic landmark of Brunel's Clifton Suspension Bridge, and one of the oldest zoos in the world – Bristol Zoo Gardens - are also very close by.

Out and about, Bristol offers a perfect base for exploring the wider region. The city is just 15 minutes by train from the world heritage city of Bath, the Somerset coast and countryside and the Cotswolds are also within easy reach. Attractions are plentiful with historic Berkeley Castle, Avon Valley Railway, Cheddar Caves & Gorge, the Wildfowl and Wetlands Centre at Slimbridge, Tyntesfield Estate and the beauty of Westonbirt Arboretum all within a short drive of Bristol.
